#### Postgraduate Taught Experience Survey (PTES) 2010

#### **Analysis of Main Results**

PTES ran for the first time in 2010 and Imperial took part in the survey for the first time this year. Students were contacted to take part in the online survey during spring 2010 ( $14^{th}$  April –  $28^{th}$  May). Around 70 UK HEIs took part in the survey.

646 Imperial students responded to the survey from an expected pool of 3000, this is a 21.5% response rate.

The core question categories were:

- A Motivations
- B Quality of teaching and learning
- C Assessment and Feedback
- D Dissertation
- E Organisation and Management
- F Learning Resources
- G Skills and Personal Development
- H Career and professional development
- I Overall Satisfaction

A summary of the responses to these questions is contained in this paper. Additional questions were added to the survey which were only available to Imperial students, these included questions related to the Graduate Schools and events, transferable skills training, recruitment and registration.

All students were asked to provide background personal information such as their department, age, gender, course type, previous qualifications etc.

#### Motivations

The first section asked students to tick all statements that applied to them in response to two questions related to their motivations for choosing their course and institution.

- My main motivations for taking this postgraduate programme were:

(top 3 responses)

- 1) To improve my employment prospects
- 2) Personal interest
- 3) To progress in my current career path (i.e. a professional qualification)
- I am studying for this qualification at this particular institution because of:

(top 3 responses)

- 1) The overall reputation of the institution
- 2) The institution's reputation in my chosen subject area
- 3) The location of the institution

In the remaining sections all the questions which are summarised in this document were in the format:

Responses were converted to scores, as shown in brackets above, for analysis.

College level results were also analysed as a percentage of respondents selecting each of the options (excluding respondents who selected Not Applicable).


## **Quality of Teaching and Learning**

- c) Staff are enthusiastic about what they are teaching



- f) Feedback on my work has helped me clarify things I did not understand



- f) My supervisor provides helpful feedback on my progress









## **College and Russell Group Average Scores by Question Category**




The average response rate for all Russell group institutions who participated in the survey (excluding Imperial) was 18.2%.


