

StudentShapers Recruitment: Calling all medical students

Exciting opportunity to engage with the Undergraduate Primary Care Education team to:

- Develop a new module on Social Prescribing
- Shape a more equitable, community-engaged primary care curriculum
 - Co-produce accessible educational resources on LGBTQ+ issues.

Bursary: £55 per week; part-time for 22 weeks. (£1210 in total)

Who should apply: Only students enrolled in medicine should apply.

Campus/Location: Project engagement will take place primarily via Microsoft Teams.

Project details: The project will run from 4 October to 28 March and involves a Student Shaper collaborating with undergraduate primary care faculty to co-develop and implement a short course in social prescribing (including a unique collaborative workshop with key stakeholders), co-create a student-facing, community-engaged learning resource relating to LGBTQ health equity and social prescribing relevant to the LGBTQ community, and support development of a community-engaged curriculum and our broader community engagement strategy.

The Student Shaper will gain experience in community engagement, medical education and project management and develop teamwork and leadership skills through collaborating with faculty on a real-time project with potential meaningful impact.
