



StudentShapers Recruitment: Calling all FoM Master's students

Developing online learning to aid transition to Master's level study in FoM

Bursary: £50 per week x 17 weeks = Total of £850.00

Who should apply: Current Master's students from Faculty of Medicine (or PhD students providing they have recently studied at Master's level within this Faculty)

Campus/Location: South Kensington (can be flexible)

Project details: The Faculty of Medicine (FoM) is the first within Imperial College to initiate curriculum review across all of its Postgraduate Programmes, taking place in the previous academic year and currently in its implementation phase. In light of all our curricular changes, within Postgraduate Medicine we appreciate the critical importance of thoroughly setting expectations in order that our students can effectively transition and excel in such an innovative and challenging learning environment. Therefore, we are looking to develop an online, non-credit bearing online short course designed for students in PG Medicine to complete prior to the commencement of MSc/ MRes study. This online course will be an essential 'induction' into Master's level study in PG Medicine at ICL, focussing on Master's students setting expectations of themselves and their learning experience, designed in an active and reflective manner for deep learning. This will enhance parity of student experience and address College/ Faculty agendas such as equality, diversity and inclusivity and enhancing the student experience, creating a "baseline" of preparation for all Master's students in FoM. This StudentShapers project will strongly focus on the development of this pre-arrival course; as StudentShapers you will act as co-creators in the course design process on a weekly basis over a period of 17 weeks (approx. half a day per week).
