- Students who graduated from the GH BSc in June 2019 (only if currently a student at ICL)

Project details

We are looking for **2 motivated students to join our team over the spring and summer terms**. This project aims to support the review of the Global Health BSc curriculum via a process of collaborative education design with current students/recent alumni. The GH BSc course has undergone a significant curriculum review over the last 2 years. Since its inception 10 years ago, we have steadily developed a student-centered approach to learning. As the course enters the final "evaluation and iterative refinement phase" of the curriculum review, we are seeking to continue working in partnership with students.

A timeline of the role is included below.

Students will be involved as partners in the team and their voices valued in each step of the design process. Their engagement will be sought mostly on Module 1 curriculum design and Module 2 (CGP). If possible, StudentShapers' input will also be sought for Module 2 (Lit Review) and Module 3.

Administrative support will be available and StudentShapers will not be expected to replace the administrator or course lead. However, they will be encouraged to take ownership of the module design projects. They will also be consulted with regards to the development of 4 assessments although they will not be leading on these.

Why apply?

The scheme offers a valuable opportunity to gain experience in education development activities which is not available in the general curriculum. It is also an opportunity to develop transferrable skills including partnership and cocreation work further. As a StudentShaper, your recent experience as a student will be considered an asset within the team.

Timeline of the project

This timeline is partially flexible and some of this work can be carried out remotely. However, arrangements will need to be decided with the course leads in advance of the project starting.

- Phase 1: half a day a week March to May 2020 [Wedn 18 March- Wedn 6 May 2020]
- Phase 2: full time mid-May to July 2020 (for external students, this is subject to their home university dates for the following academic year) [Mon 25 May- Fri 12 June]
- Phase 3: 2 days to take part in teaching in September 2020 (for both internal and external students this will be dependent on their schedule for the following academic year. External students will receive funding to travel)

How to apply

Pease send an expression of interest to Mariam Sbaiti by <u>Wednesday 4 March 2020</u> including a brief statement (300-500 words) of why you wish to engage with the project, what motivates you and any relevant experience. If you have requirements with regards to the timeline of the project. Please include these above and explain your time availability.

Informal meetings may be used if necessary though it is likely that the selection will be based entirely on statements (this process is in line with StudentShaper guidelines).
