

StudentShapers Recruitment: Calling all medical students

Project title: Equality, diversity and inclusion: Shaping an inclusive primary care curriculum.

Bursary: Students will be paid £50 for three hours per week, for up to 19 weeks.

Who should apply? Undergraduate medical students (any year of study).

Campus/Location: Reynolds Building, Charing Cross Campus, Margravine Rd, Hammersmith, W6 8RP. Communication may take place remotely using Microsoft Teams in view of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Project details: We are seeking three StudentShapers for up to 19 weeks (November 2020 - April 2021) to join our Undergraduate Primary Care Education team.

StudentShapers will work as part of our team to review pre-existing course materials and co-create new and inclusive learning materials for one of these three key courses:


- Patients, Communities and Healthcare (Year 1 and 2 courses where students learn about the biological, psychological and social aspects of health)
- Longitudinal Integrated Apprenticeship (a pilot course for a cohort of Year 5 students)
- Medicine in the Community Apprenticeship (a Year 3 course which involves students being placed in GP surgeries and working with local communities).

Alongside further embedding diversity and inclusion within the curriculum, StudentShapers will support research exploring how to create a learning environment that protects, embraces and promotes authenticity among medical students from ethnic minority backgrounds. StudentShapers will further develop key transferable skills in critical thinking, leadership and teamwork.

This role provides a unique and exciting opportunity for students to: help shape a curriculum that inclusively reflects the needs, experiences, and priorities of students from diverse and underrepresented backgrounds and that supports students to develop into doctors who are equipped to address health inequalities and work effectively and inclusively with diverse patients and communities.
