Development and sustainability of the Imperial MathWiki

Bursary: £390 per week for 3 weeks full time work (exact dates tbc but to take place over summer 2024).

Who should apply: We are looking for 2 mathematics undergraduate students to take as partners on the project. One would ideally be from years 1 or 2 and the other from years 2 or 3.

Campus/Location: South Kensington, though we will most likely take meetings remotely so the project can almost fully run remotely.

Project details:

We want to develop further the content on the student driven MathWiki pages, both adding new modules, improving and enhancing some of the current content, and ensuring that the content and platform has a plan for sustainability and use throughout the department in the future.

On this project you would be expected to bring your skills in mathematics content development: writing and producing clear, helpful notes and developing useful examples to be used by your fellow peers. As a result, a strong background in programming is not required, but much of the project will involve you developing online resources, so some competency in programming is preferred.

We want to ensure the MathWiki becomes a well-used, sustainable, resource within our department, so we would be looking for students that brought a passion for its development and had a strong desire to encourage and spread its use within the department.
