## Calling all medical students in Years 5 or 6

Do you want to help to improve the Phase 3a GPPHC module?

Bursary: £880 (3 hours/week for 16 weeks in total).

Who should apply: Students enrolled on the MBBS in years 5 and 6 are eligible to apply.

Campus/Location: Reynolds Building, Charing Cross Campus on Wednesdays or Fridays (with potential for some remote involvement).

Project details: This is an exciting opportunity to work in partnership with the Undergraduate Primary Care Education team to review and update the GPPHC module and modify the workplace-based assessments within the module for future Phase 3a medical students. For example, with your input, we hope to redesign the student guidance for the GPPHC Patient Project to support students to adopt a more inclusive approach when reflecting on a patient's illness journey. Together, we will consider how best to incorporate other diverse or creative methods of reflection, rather than solely through the current required PowerPoint presentation.

This project will involve one Student Shaper working collaboratively with the Undergraduate Primary Care Education primary team, and will provide the opportunity to:

- Have an active role in adapting current module materials and shape the future of the GPPHC module curriculum and assessment
- Co-create a more inclusive assessment for future GPPHC students, drawing on a range of creative approaches to allow for deeper and more impactful and meaningful reflection

Through participation of this project, you will not only have a unique experience of curriculum development, but will also develop your leadership, prioritisation, and teamwork skills, working within a supportive team. Once implemented, there is scope to evaluate any new assessments, and we would plan to share innovative work through this project through possible publications and/or conference presentations.
