

StudentShapers Recruitment: Calling all undergraduate students

Teaching and Assessment in an Artificial Intelligence World

Bursary: £1825 each (5 weeks at £365 per week – 2 StudentShaper positions available)

Who should apply:

This opportunity is open to interested undergraduate students from across Imperial. Priority will be given to recruiting two students from different academic disciplines.

Campus/Location: The project will operate primarily remotely. Some activity may take place on the South Kensington campus as needed.

Project details:

Generative artificial intelligence, as made available through tools such as ChatGPT, is likely to be used widely in educational settings, employment and wider society. Universities including Imperial are still determining how best to respond to this technology. During this project, the two student partners will collaborate with the staff partner to conduct some small-scale research tasks and to construct best practice guidelines regarding how artificial intelligence can be used ethically and appropriately for teaching and assessment at Imperial (and in STEMM subjects more widely). The student partners will help to co-design the research and will benefit from working on an area of topical interest across the sector. This project is most suited to student partners with interests in academic integrity, conducting research and using emerging technologies. There may be the opportunity for student partners to present the outcomes of this project internally and externally.

Please submit an expression of interest of between 300 and 500 words detailing why you want to engage with the project. These will then be distributed directly to the appropriate staff partner. Informal interviews or meetings may be used as part of the selection process.
