Project Submission Instructions for MSc Students

Please submit your FINAL electronic MSc Project in a PDF format by 4:00pm, THURSDAY 12th SEPTEMBER 2024. Note: close to this deadline the electronic upload may become slow. You are strongly advised to have an early upload in place at least one hour before the deadline in case any last-minute submission goes wrong. It is your responsibility to submit everything on time.

You can re-submit a newer version of your project anytime up to the deadline; the **latest version present in the App** on **12th September at 4pm** will be accepted.

You will have an in-person Turnitin session with the EEE librarian who will show you how Turnitin can be used to support you in avoiding plagiarism, how to generate a Similarity report and how to interpret a Similarity report. This session will not be recorded.

BLACKBOARD SUBMISSION FOR REPORT PLAGIARISM CHECKING

You can submit early versions (separated by 24 hours) of your project report to the Blackboard module: MSc Cohort 2023-24 for Turnitin checking. You should already be enrolled in this module. Once you have uploaded your report PDF, you can then download a Turnitin Similarity Report. The final Turnitin report you generate needs to be submitted alongside your final project. Please note that the Turnitin report is not assessed.

Once you submit your project report on Blackboard for Turnatin checking, you cannot resubmit another version for 24 hours. You must leave sufficient time before the deadline to ensure you can submit the final version of your Final Project Report along with the Similarity Report for assessment.

IMPORTANT: FINAL REPORT SUBMISSION

1. Your Final Project Report and your Turnitin Similarity Report from Blackboard must be submitted on time to the <u>EEE app</u> (as below).

Important: Please prioritise uploading your Final Project Report. If you encounter issues with the Turnitin Similarity Report, please address them after submitting your project.

- 2. Allow time for EEE app uploads near the deadline. Slow upload is not a valid mitigating circumstance for failure to meet the deadline, and many uploads at the same time will make the system slow.
- 3. You are strongly advised to upload a "safety" report copy more than two hours before the deadline.
- 4. Incorrect use of images in a PDF document can lead to very large PDF size. Any report larger than 30MB should be PDF compressed before upload. This can be done with a web compression utility, such as Adobe. Check how to do this well before the deadline.

FINAL REPORT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- 2. To submit your Project:
 - a. Click on Submit Project button
 - b. Student can update the project title before submitting the report. If there is no change click *Continue without Change* button



- c. On the submit Project page: Choose a file to upload and click on Upload button
- 3. Once the Project is submitted a Download Project button will appear on the dashboard under the download column and you will receive a successful upload confirmation from the system.
