## Using the Physics Department's Standard Calculator

The physics department now provides **one** standard calculator for use in exams. You are advised to ensure you are comfortable using the Casio fx-83GT Plus ahead of the exams you will be sitting.

Please note that as of 1 January 2014, the old model previously used, Casio fx-83ES, will no longer be provided.

Calculator	Casio fx-83GT Plus
Photo	CASIO
Math IO mode	[Shift] [Mode] [1] Displays equation as they would appear on paper.
Set Deg/Rad	[Shift] [Mode] [3] for degrees [Shift] [Mode] [4] for radians
Enter Statistics mode:	MODE 2 1 (STAT) (1-VAR) Single variable mode.
Data entry:	Enter data pressing [=] after each entry.  Press [AC] to complete data entry.  (this last step is important as otherwise any statistical quantities you calculate will be added to your list of data, distorting any subsequent calculations)
To calculate statistical quantities:	[Shift] [1] [4] to access Var menu  then, for example [2] [=] for the mean (you will find the two types of standard deviation that you might need to calculate in the same "Var" menu)
To leave statistics mode	Press [Mode] [1]
