To Whom It May Concern:

The Department of Physics at Imperial College London is releasing this note to current undergraduate students to help prospective employers and others interpret their transcripts.

There was significant industrial action in the Higher Education sector during the 2022-2023 academic year, including at Imperial College. This included periods of Marking and Assessment Boycotts (MAB). In some cases, staff that participated in MAB declined to mark exams and other forms of assessments. As a result, many students have progressed into their next year of study, missing marks in one or more course elements. In such cases, a score of "0.00*" has been recorded on the student's official transcript.

We want to reassure anyone reviewing the transcripts that the "0.00*" record is provisional and only included for procedural reasons to allow students' progression. It does not reflect the student's performance in that element of their degree course. The College will update the students' transcripts once all marking of assessments are finalised.
