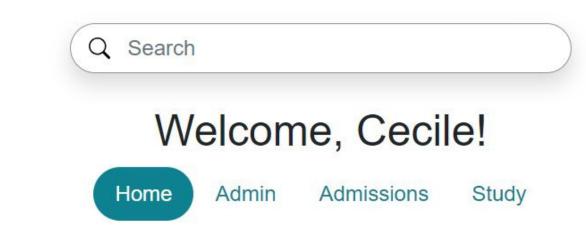

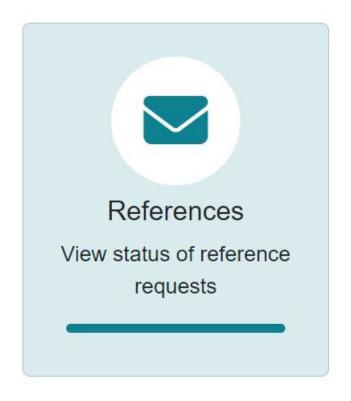

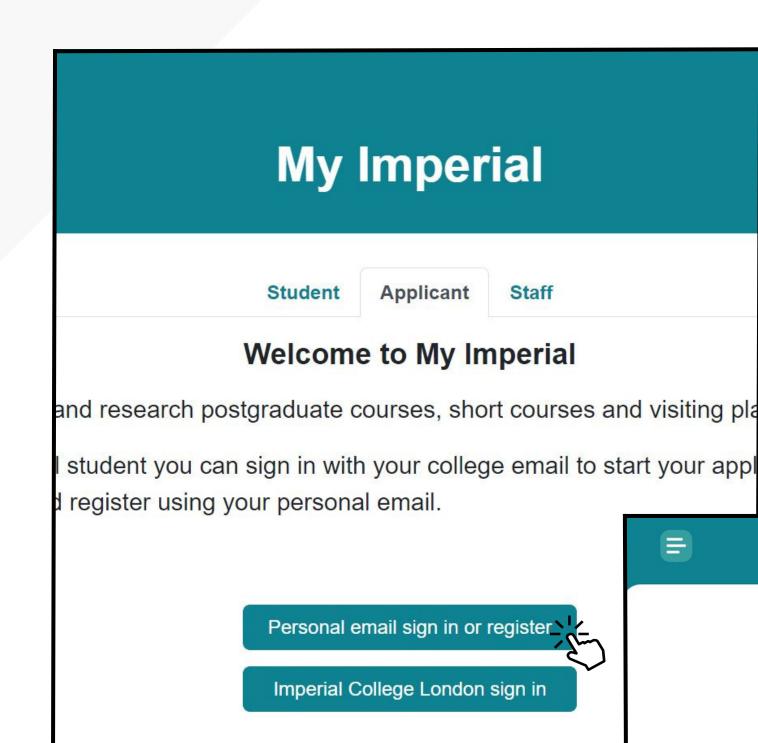
- Monitoring email

- Accept unconditional offer
- Enrol 30 days before start of programme

# BEFORE YOU APPLY

We recommend that you have the following organised and ready to submit

- **Records of previous, formal qualifications**, including certificates, transcripts, degrees and degree equivalents confirming the title of your awarded qualification and the date it was received
- Documentation that proves a change of name if this is different to what is listed on your degree document.
- Contact information for two recent and relevant referees, either academic or professional
- The College requires proof of English language qualification. Please check your required qualification <a href="here">here</a>.
- If you are registered on a course at another institution and that course overlaps with the DHL course, you must deregister from your course before you will be permitted to enrol on DHL!

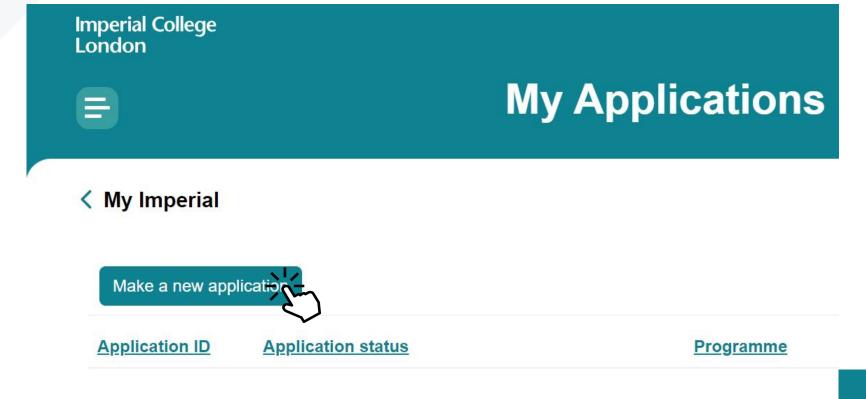

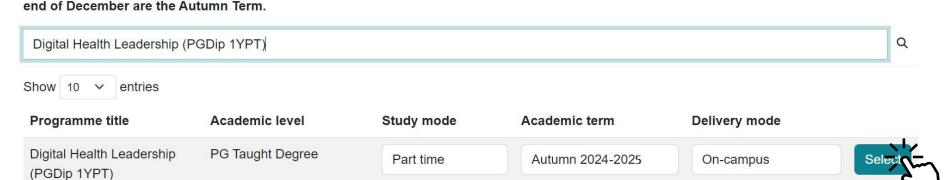
# FINDING YOUR PROGRAMME

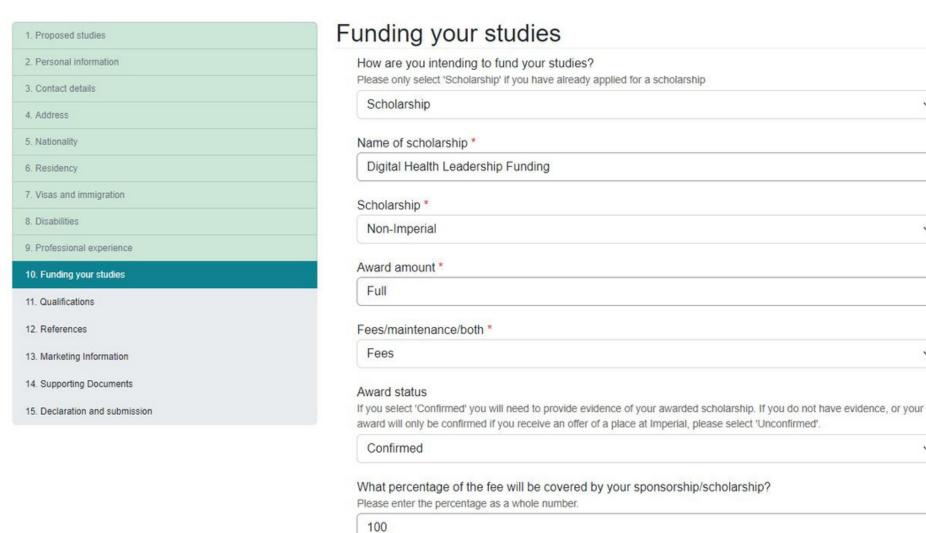

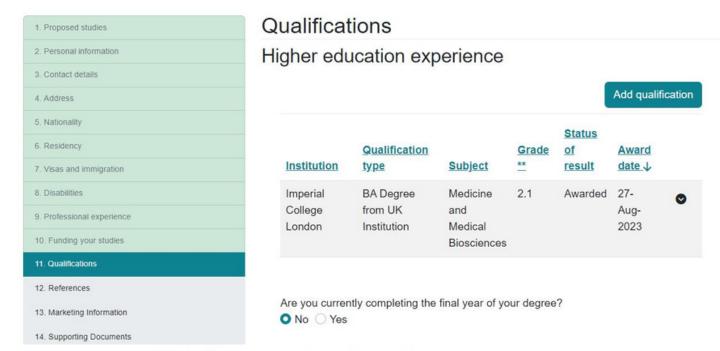

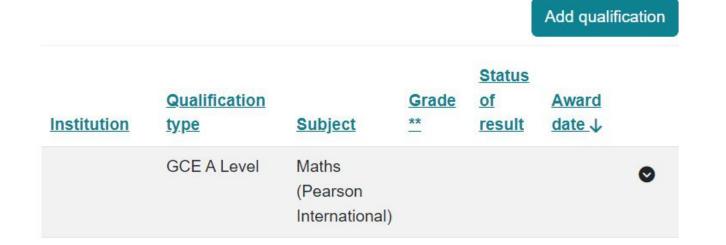

#### CV

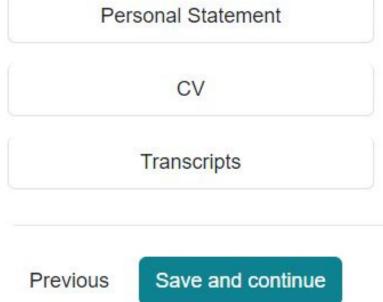
• NHS England application form is satisfactory

#### **Transcript**

- Must show: full name, name of the awarding institution, date awarded, and award received
- If your name has changed, you will be asked to provide documentation (ex: marriage certificate)
- <u>Contact us</u> to discuss a placeholder document if you are unable to locate your transcript at this stage. You will be asked to submit a more formal, verified transcript once your receive a conditional offer

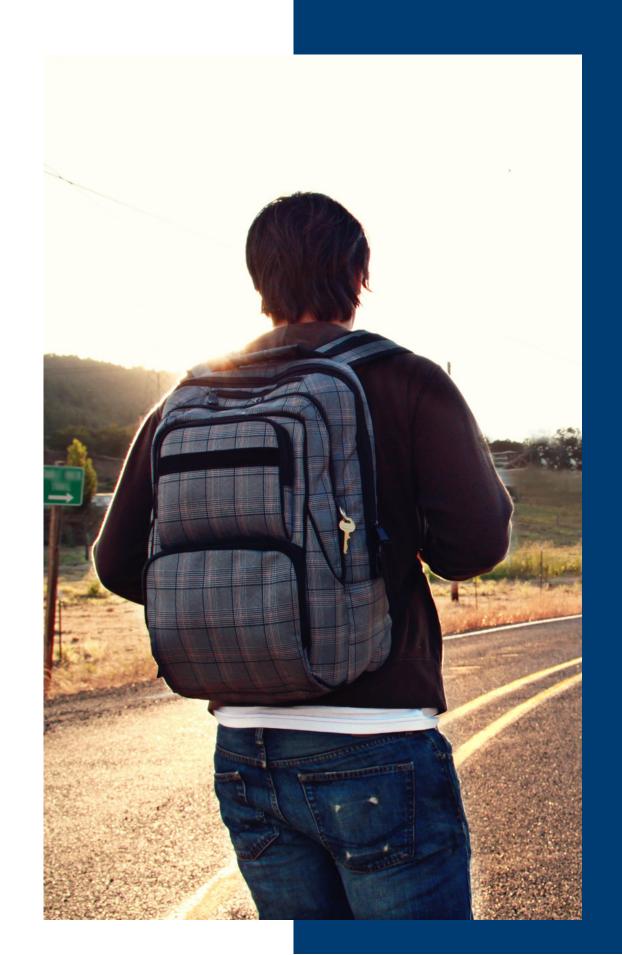

# WHAT COMES NEXT?

- Email confirmation + CID Number
- Track your Application through My Imperial
- Central Admission checks documents + initial assessment
- Application sent to academic department for review
- Decision communicated through My Imperial and email Accept offer as quickly as possible (28 days to accept)
- Fulfil your offer conditions (usually):
  - Previous academic records, degrees or transcripts
  - Proof of English Language ability (if required)



# PREVIOUS ACADEMIC RECORD

- This is different from the transcript you were asked to provide as supporting document during the initial application phase.
- This is a crucial phase where Imperial College can officially verify your academic records and confirm you have met that condition.
- For those with qualifications where your university has a secure digital e-transcript verification service or HEAR, you should use this method. Otherwise you should verify your degree award using the online Qualification Check service. Details will be provided in your offer.
- Engage with this stage promptly, or you will experience delays
  accessing the materials and communications from the department.
   You WILL NOT receive an unconditional offer and be allowed to
  enrol without completing this step.



# ENROLLING ON THE COURSE

- Unconditional offer: once you fulfill offer conditions
- Late July: Receive request to enrol on the programme
- Online registration opens **30 days** before start of class
